Entries & Closing Date

All entries must be RECEIVED by the Trial Secretary by June 1. Entries will not be accepted and cannot be canceled after the closing date of June 1. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees. Entries will be accepted by Express Mail only if the Signature Waiver is signed. You must file a separate entry form if you enter more than one dog (i.e., only one dog per form.) Advancement in levels will be accepted IN WRITING no later than 6 P.M. on Monday, June 7th. Contact Kimberly Ingraham at paws4funvt@gmail.com or write her at PO Box 345, Plainfield, VT 05667-0345.

Registration of Dogs

All dogs must be registered with USDAA® (registration has a "U" prefix) in order to compete. The registration form included with this Agility Test Schedule must be completed and submitted with any entry that does not bear a valid USDAA® registration number. **To get a registration number immediately and a height card prior to the show, go online to www.usdaa.com, click on General Information, Dog Registration.**

Check-In and Starting Times

Competitor set-up begins Friday, June 11, at 3:00 p.m. Check-in for dogs that do not require measuring will be from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Friday. CHECK IN FOR ALL DOGS, INCLUDING THOSE REQUIRING MEASUREMENT, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Dogs requiring measurement should be available for measurement at 7:00 a.m. Sunday check-in and measurement is only for dogs not present on Saturday. Judge's briefings are expected to begin at 7:45 a.m. each day, with the first class starting at 8:00 a.m.. All dogs must be measured unless the dog is jumping 26"Ch/22"P, a permanent card, temporary card with 3 measurements awaiting a CMJ or check-in letter issued by USDAA/print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded is presented at time of check-in. Notification of early measurement on Friday evening will be sent with the confirmation.

Rules and Regulations

Rules and regulations of the United States Dog Agility Association currently in effect shall apply at this event. Competitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations. The rule book may be viewed online at www.usdaa.com.

Awards

Test Classes: Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs placing 1st through 4th in each jump height of most classes as well as in Pairs in the mini and open divisions. All qualifying scores will be awarded a maroon qualifying ribbon. New Title Rosettes will be awarded for new titles earned at this trial.

Grand Prix/National Standard: See tournament description for awards.

Steeplechase/Speed Jumping: See tournament description for awards.

All prizes and awards must be claimed prior to the end of the trial. Sorry, no ribbons will be mailed.

Special Awards

The **Katy Schultz Memorial Award** will be won by the dog and handler who, in the judge's opinion, had the most fun together in Saturday's Starters/PI Standard class. The winner of the Katy Award will receive a special rosette and a very special prize.

Special "Big Fat Zero" T-Shirts for each competitor who manages to earn a 0 in Snooker.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations as amended July 1, 2009, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- This test is open to all dogs at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- All dogs must be registered with the USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. Registration may be included with entry to this show. (Registration form is included in this test schedule.) To get a registration number immediately and a height card prior to the show, go online to usdaa.com, click on General Information, Dog Registration.
- Please pick up after your dogs.
- Food will be available at the show grounds for breakfast and lunch.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- Safety shall be a foremost consideration at all times. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs and/or children.
- NOMAD may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.
- Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of USDAA rules and regulations.
- No entries may be accepted, changed, altered or withdrawn for any reason after the closing date, except as provided for in the section covering Entries and Closing in this test schedule.
- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal.
- All Competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape or purchase videotape of portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial exhibition purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.
- Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS AND HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of NOMAD.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Amounts shall be paid within 30 days of postmarked notice of returned check if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse.
- All fees are payable in US Dollars.
- All dogs must be kept on leash while on the trial grounds except when competing in the ring or at the warm-up jump. No dogs may be left unattended except when properly crated in designated areas. No dogs may be left unattended overnight.
- Fault limits may be applied in any class to which they apply. Any such limits will be announced during the judge's briefings.
- This event will be held outdoors on grass in one ring. The show grounds have ample room for tents and crates. Bring your own shade. Water and baby pools will be available for cooling dogs. Grounds will be available on Friday evening for setup.
- FEO entries will not be accepted. Should a dog measure up at this event, the dog may be run FEO at the lower jump height, but no qualifying scores or awards may be earned and no change in program at check-in is permitted.

Directions to Site: Trapp Family Lodge Meadow

From Interstate 89:

- Take I 89 to exit 10 for Stowe/Waterbury.
- At the end of the ramp turn onto Rte. 100 North and head for Stowe. Go approximately 10 miles.
- At the blinking light/stop sign in Stowe Village, turn left onto Rte 108 N. (the Mountain Road)

- Follow about 2 miles to Luce Hill Road, just past The Shed Restaurant on your left
- Bear left onto Luce Hill Road. It will be flat for about 1/2 mile, then climbs about 1.5 miles to the Trapp Family Lodge. You will pass Ten Acres Lodge on your left.
- The Trapp Family Lodge will be on your right at the top of the hill.
- Continue past the Lodge about 200 yards to a meadow on the left.

Coming from the north on Rt. 100:

- Turn right onto Rt. 108 at the flashing light/stop sign in Stowe Village and follow the directions above, starting where type is green (in box).

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Two certification programs will be offered at this event – Championship & Performance. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible; however, under NO circumstance may a dog be entered in the same Championship and Performance class at this agility test. Classes include standard agility, gamblers, jumpers, pairs relay and snooker agility as set forth in Chapters 3 – 7 of USDAA Rules and Regulations, each of which are conducted at three competitive levels.

Jump heights for the Championship Program (Performance Heights shown in parenthesis):

Dog Height	Jump Height	Long Jump*	Table Height

A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3-7 of Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations.

Pairs is required for titling in all levels of Performance. Partners for both Championship and Performance Pairs must be from the same level and height division, mini (Ch 12/16, Perf 8/12) or open (Ch 22/26, Perf 16/22). In the event only one dog is entered in a program/level, dog not entered in relay or dogs from other programs/levels may not be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

The following Tournament classes are being offered at this event: (all competitors are eligible for entry to any of these tournament classes.) A copy of the tournament regulations for each tournament may be found on the USDAA website at www.usdaa.com and will be posted at the event.

The following general rules are provided for information purposes only.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and Performance Grand PrixSM - A qualifying score is zero faults. One Q is required for entry in a Regional Championship, where a bye into the semifinals may be earned. Two qualifying scores are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

Awards (Grand Prix)

First place qualifying winner in each height class shall be awarded a "bye voucher", permitting them to advance to the final round of a regional championship. A double overlay maroon and white ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers. 1st – 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height.

Awards (Performance Grand Prix)

First place qualifying winner in each height class shall be awarded a "bye voucher", permitting them to advance to the final round of a regional championship. A double overlay maroon and pink ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers. 1st-4th place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height.

Dog Agility Steeplechase®, and Performance Speed JumpingSM - These tournaments consist of two rounds, with a qualifying score being earned in Round 1. Competitors advancing to Round 2 compete for prize money, top ten points. **Steeplechase:** One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in a Regional Championships, and two are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships. **Speed Jumping:** Two qualifying scores as described in the complete rules are required for entry in the semifinals at the World Championships.

Awards (Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping):

Local Qualifiers: Prize money shall be computed based upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class. 1st-4th place rosettes will be awarded. *Allocable amounts to finalist positions that are not filled for any reason or allocable prize amounts less than \$3.00 shall not be paid.
