## CAMP NOMAD 2012

August 4-5, 2012 Stowe, VT at Trapp Family Lodge

INSTRUCTORS: KAREN HOLIK and JOHN NYS

NOMAD is once again sponsoring a 2-day agility camp with two world-class agility champions. Whether or not you've ever been to an agility camp, this is the one to attend! You will learn from the best while having fun with your NOMAD friends. READ ON!!!!

### Schedule And Topics

The camp is limited to 20 working spots (10 teams per instructor). Each group will have a full day with each instructor, geared to that group's skill level. The following guidelines may be used to determine which level is suitable for your team:

**Novice:** Teams range from being familiar with all the obstacles, to doing 3-6 obstacle sequences, to being ready for trialing.

**Intermediate:** Teams are competing at the Novice level.

**Masters:** Teams are actively competing. The dog should have achieved at least one leg in an advanced level.

Groups will be divided into Novice/Intermediate and Intermediate/Masters.

Working sessions are from 9:00 to 5:00 each day, with a 45 minute lunch break.

Topics likely to be covered during working sessions:

- Jump training
- Contacts, Table, Weaves
- Handling techniques: crosses, footwork, dog skills
- Technical pattern: pinwheel, box, threadle, pull-through, serpentine
- Course analysis and coursework

### Cost and Payment Policy

Camp costs \$250 for working members and \$400 for supporting members and non-members. This price includes dinner Saturday night; lunch is on your own. Saturday night's dinner is \$25 for invited guests who are not camp participants. Camp participation is not available on a per day basis. **Auditing by NOMAD members is free.**

**Payment Policy:** A non-refundable \$100 deposit with your registration is required by April 2 to reserve a spot. The balance of the camp fee is due by June 1st.

If you cannot attend camp and there is no waiting list, it will be your responsibility to find someone at the appropriate level for the assigned group to fill the spot in order to receive a refund.

### Registration Procedure

Registrations will be accepted in order of postmarking, starting with opening date, April 2, 2012. Please note: any applications received prior to April 2 will be treated as if they were postmarked April 2. Checks will be deposited May 1. After May 1, if camp has not filled, it will be opened up to non members.

In the event that we receive more than 20 applications for camp postmarked on or before April 2, we will use the following priority system to assign spots to members:

**First:** members of NOMAD since April 2011, who have completed 20 plus hours as a working member or are supporting members.

**Second:** new NOMAD members.

**Third:** working NOMAD members who have not completed their 20 hours of service.

Registrations will be available to non-members on May 1, if any vacancies exist.

The seminar committee will determine which members have completed 20 plus hours, with support from the steering committee if needed. If there are too many applications at any priority level, the seminar committee will use a lottery to determine the remaining slots.

### Camp Rules

- You must clean up after your dog on the camp grounds and all surrounding areas AND at any lodging facility.
- All dogs must be on a leash except when working.
- Bitches in season are not allowed.
- Campers with working spot must stay with their assigned groups. You may work with alternate dogs during the weekend, but your alternate dog must be at or above the level of the dog you registered for camp. Only one dog per handler may be worked in each 3 1/2 hour session.
- Rules for practicing during off hours will be announced at the beginning of camp.
- Auditor's dogs are not allowed in the working area during camp hours and are not allowed on equipment.

#### KAREN HOLIK

Karen and her sheltie Sizzle are nine-time AKC/USA World Team Members, four-time National Champions at the United States Dog Agility World Championships, and Silver Medalists at the prestigious FCI World Agility Championships. Karen has also been a Finalist at National Events here in the United States with each of her dogs (past and present) over the past 15 years.

Karen began participating in dog agility in 1992 when she started training her Chow/Sheltie mix, Simon. She loves training dogs of all motivation levels. Her success with many breeds demonstrates her effectiveness. She believes that all dogs can be taught to run to their full potential, and agility should be a team sport and fun for the dog at all times. She believes the most important aspects of agility training are teaching the fundamentals and being consistent with your handling at all times.

Karen currently owns 4 dogs (two Shelties and two Border Collies). She teaches private/group lessons and classes in Brandon, Florida. She also travels the United States, as well as Puerto Rico, Bermuda, Mexico and Costa Rica, giving seminars.

#### JOHN NYS

John began his love of animals over twenty-five years ago when he began riding and training horses. He competed competitively with horses for twenty years earning numerous awards and titles, including Massachusetts Barrel Racing Champion in 2002. While on "road" at a rodeo, he saw an agility competition. The following day, he began training his first dog, Casey, and the rest is history.

John has achieved seven American Kennel Club MACH titles on two different dogs. He has also competed in the AKC National Championships where he earned six final round placements. John finished 3rd overall at the AKC National Agility Championships in 2008, 5th overall at the AKC National Agility Championships in 2009, and 2nd at the AKC National Agility Championships in

2010. John co-owns Rush with Paulette Swartzendruber who was on the AKC World Team in 2008 and 2009.

John was presented the opportunity of a lifetime when he began showing Rush in 2009. His dreams came true in 2010 when he made the AKC World Team with Rush in the Medium Dog Division and with his Sheltie, Blink, as an alternate, in the Small Dog Division. John and Rush went on to win the Individual Silver Medal in the Medium Dog Division in the 2010 FCI Agility World Championships in Reiden, Germany. Within a few weeks of returning from Germany, John and Rush competed in Kentucky at the USDAA National Championship and became the 2010 USDAA Grand Prix National Champion!

How you handle the opening sequence of a course will set the tone for the rest of your run. This class will look at four different opening sequences from a variety of courses (two per week). Participants will learn the best way for their teams to handle each opening sequence. Whether you have a lead-out or not, are a beginner or advanced handler, have a fast dog or a slow dog, you will learn how to handle the first 7 to 10 obstacles of a course successfully (and look good doing it!). Teams do not need to be trialing, but should be confident on all obstacles and be able to sequence at least eight obstacles. # **Silencing the Inner Critic**

We all have a voice inside our heads that has been referred to as the inner critic. It's the voice that says you can't, that you aren't good enough, that you should be afraid, and a multitude of other negative things. In some people that voice is louder and in others it is quieter...but one of the keys to being successful is to learn how to cope with this inner critic.

This inner voice develops over a period of time. Babies don't have this voice. It becomes a voice we acquire as we grow. Our environment can certainly shape what that voice is saying. If we grow up being told we are no good, it is more likely that inner voice will say the same thing. However, how does that explain those who come out of poor situations to become incredibly successful, or the converse situation, those who have every opportunity and squander it away?

You can't control your environment, but you can control your reaction to that environment, **IF YOU CHOOSE TO**. No more "yeah, buts..."

So...here are some strategies to help silence the inner critic and let your real voice, the voice that believes in you, be heard. Every time a negative thought arises, use one of the following:

- Imagine your inner critic has a volume control or on/off switch. When the inner critic kicks in, see yourself flicking the switch to "off" or turning the volume down to zero and then blasting the positive voice.
- The spoken word is more powerful than the thought. When you hear the inner critic, say out loud, "Stop" or "NO" and then replace the negative thought with a spoken, empowering word or phrase, even something simple like "I CAN do this!" or "Bring it on!"
- Imagine the negative thought blowing up or vanishing in a puff or going up in flame and the positive thought leaping into its place.
- Think of picture, place, thing, or moment in time that reminds you of your strength, your abilities and your talents.
- Shake your head to reject the negative thought, and stand up tall and straight and look the problem in the eye, accepting the challenge.

With any of these strategies (and there are many more), make sure the positive replacement thought triggers an empowering emotion. The reason the negative voice is so powerful is it strikes at your emotions, at incorrect negative beliefs you hold that give power to that negative thought. Make your positive emotion more powerful!

There may be times when you hear the inner critic but from today forward you won't give the critic any power. This doesn't mean you won't objectively look at a situation to learn where you can improve, but assessing where you can improve is much different from telling yourself you are no good and not capable. Silencing the critic means actively rejecting fear and negativity directed towards yourself and developing the belief that you are capable of doing and achieving anything you set your mind to.
