## **MinutesNOMAD Steering Committee**

at Army Corps of Engineers office, Essex February 4, 2013 7 pm

**Present:** John Marcus, Judy Frey, Linda Ladd, Roberta Dumas, Marty Abair, Sarah Albert

**Finance:** Linda reviewed the financial reports with us. Gross income was \$34,485 this year, and since IRS regulations for non-profit organizations may have changed, we might have exceeded the threshold for needing to file a 990 tax return. Linda explained that having to file a 990 entails stating whether various internal financial controls are in place. One of these controls, which Linda would already like us to be doing already, is submitting a detailed list accompanying checks that are given to her, with the number, date and name from each check.

There is over \$19,000 in the checking account now, earning no interest. John moved and Marty seconded, that Linda should move \$7,000 into a money market account. All voted affirmative. The annual audit will be completed before the spring membership meeting.

**CPE trial:** Marty has still been unable to hear whether CPE has accepted us as a host club. She sent in the NOMAD application last October.

**Equipment:** Roberta had a list of equipment that the equipment committee would like to sell. We agreed that there's no point in having two sets of equipment since we're unlikely to be holding a 2-ring trial, and their sale would create more room in the trailer, making equipment storage and moving easier. We voted in favor of auctioning off this equipment at the cleanup day in May. We will be purchasing a new rubberized A-frame with wheels in April.

**Practice:** If roads are bad, it makes sense to cancel and save the rental fee for that day. However, if it's a question of only a few people coming to practice that day we shouldn't cancel based on that. Nor do we want to require people to commit to Saturday attendance ahead of time. During the months we have league it makes sense to have the barn for 4 hours, but with no lessons or league in the first session, the people who come to Sat. practice are often spread thin over the morning & afternoon sessions.

The practice committee/facilitators should make the decision on whether the weather/road conditions are bad enough to cancel. We feel we've made a commitment to Stephanie for barn rental this winter and don't want to change the arrangement. However, the practice committee should come up with a plan for barn use next year to address the low attendance issue: possibly fewer hours each week, alternate practice and run-throughs, etc.

Billie had asked the SC to consider whether the Wednesday practice sessions should be brought under the NOMAD umbrella. However, the practice committee had previously said they didn't want to have responsibility for Wednesdays, and the current arrangement seems to be working well, so we'll inform Billie that we don't see any advantage of NOMAD taking them over.

**Membership:** It was mentioned that there are people listed as working members who don't seem to be fulfilling their work requirement. We thought that using a checklist of various tasks/ committees worked on during the year might be better than asking everyone to estimate the number of hours worked. Also we might want to consider limiting the number of slots on committees to assure that everyone on a committee gets an opportunity to contribute.

**Spring meeting:** Roberta will check whether Richmond church is available on Monday, 4/29 at 7pm. Sarah will make meeting announcement and ask committee chairs to submit reports. Agenda items for meeting: audit committee, nominating committee, limiting number of slots on committees.

The steering committee meeting adjourned at 8:45 pm. Thanks to Marty for making her office available to us.
