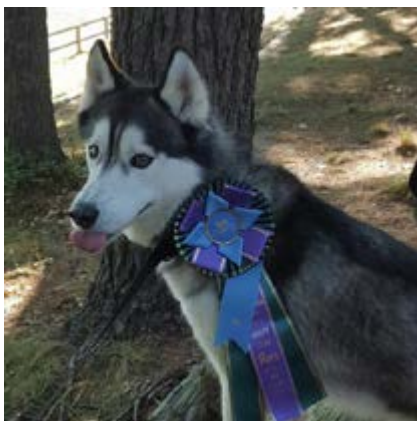

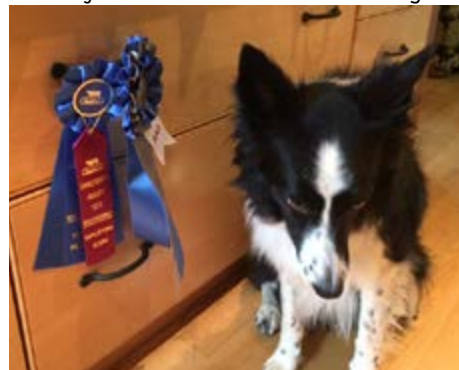

Trials – NADAC/CPE: Attendance was way down at the August NADAC trial, but it did make a small profit. Should we talk about holding a CPE trial? What area are we drawing from? Do we need to consider alternative trial locations?

Finances: Has Roberta already bought the new tunnels? Will the old ones be auctioned? Does Linda need support from the SC with the budget? (she was unable to attend today) Judy will ask the people who have questions about the budget to contact Linda before the Fall meeting. Lisa expressed hope that there is a way to use our cash reserve to benefit our membership without presenting a deficit budget.

Fall elections: The nominating committee (Kit, Ann and Lisa B. volunteered at the Spring membership meeting) needs to begin working on soliciting members to fill upcoming vacancies on the SC this fall: President, VP, Secretary and Treasurer terms all expire this year. Future nominations will need to adjust terms lengths in order to avoid having all positions expire at the same time, for example: President and Secretary, 2 years, VP & Treasurer, 1 year.

Charity donation: Kelley has received only one suggestion so far. Last year we had several good ones; she'll send out another request for donations.

We also want to remind members that NOMAD recognizes and commemorates each dog loss through our yearly contribution to the selected charity. In the past the club acknowledged some people's illness or misfortune, while others were inadvertently overlooked. It's too difficult for the club officers to oversee that this is done equitably, so if an individual wants to send condolences, get well cards or flowers to another member for any occasion, that person is responsible for arranging it.

Other: Kelley asked how we could attract more junior handlers to the club. We agreed that it's beyond the scope of SC, but there were suggestions that if we held a demo or PR event at the right location we might attract interest from younger people. After discussion it was decided that there appears to be a need to restart the demo committee.

Reminders: Lisa will send the volunteer hours link to the list again as a reminder to enter time into the database and also contact the nominating committee. Kelley will send out another request for names of charities. Judy will send out announcement of the Fall meeting time & location. Sarah will send out a reminder to committees to submit their budgets to Linda and reports to her.
