Schedule

Weekend Workshops will be comprised of four sessions with five teams per session, for a total of 20 working teams. Skill levels will be Pre-Novice/Novice and Advanced/Masters. Each session will be four hours long. The schedule for the weekend with Tara Baggerman is as follows:

8:30 AM to 12:30 PM – Advanced/Masters

1:30 PM to 5:30PM Pre-Novice/Novice

Sunday March 6, 2016

8:30 AM to 12:30 PM – Pre –Novice/Novice

1:30PM to 5:30PM Advanced/Masters

Registration & Payment Policies

The Weekend Workshops with Tara Baggerman are \$125 for working members in 2015; \$175 for supporting members in 2015; \$175 for non-members. Registration opens January 11, 2016 for NOMAD members and on January 25, 2016 for non-members. Closing date is February 22, 2016.

Payment must be made in full to reserve your spot. No refunds will be given for withdrawals from the workshop after the closing date of February 22, 2016, unless the working slot is filled by another team or you have a bitch that comes in season.

If you have registered and find you cannot attend and there is no waiting list, it will be your responsibility to find someone at the appropriate level for the assigned group to fill your spot in order for you to receive a refund. Please check to see if there is a waiting list before giving your spot away.

Registrants will get a place in Weekend Workshops based on the order of postmark, beginning with January 11, 2016. All registrations received before January 11 will be considered postmarked on January 11. If we receive 20 or fewer registrations postmarked January 11, 2016 or earlier, they will get a spot in the workshop.

If we receive more than 20 registrations postmarked January 11, 2016 or earlier, they will be accepted in this order of priority:

First: Working and supporting members in 2015

Second: Any member wishing to take a second session.

Third: Any member wishing to take a third session.

Fourth: Any member wishing to take a fourth session .

Fifth: Anyone who is not a NOMAD member.

If there is a tie for the last spot in a Weekend Workshop, the spot will be filled by a drawing.

Registrations postmarked after January 11, 2016 and before February 22, 2016 will be accepted in order of postmark.

If we go over our limit of 20 on any one postmark day, registrations will be accepted this way: All registrations postmarked before that day will have a spot in the workshop. All registrations postmarked on the day we go over 20 will be accepted in the order of priority listed above.

Full refund if you withdraw before February 22, 2016.

Registrations will be available to non-members on January 25, 2016 if any vacancies exist.
