Fine tune your agility handling with Jessica Ajoux. "As a handler, Jessica aims to be as precise and theoretically correct as possible. Her style is to stay out of the dog's way and not rush it. She likes to use a balance of techniques and handle in front of the dog as well as behind. She wants to have all the possible tools there are, so that no matter what she sees on the course, she has a solution. When Jessica is coaching her students, it's important for her to make sure they understand what they are doing and why. This goes for both the handlers and the dogs."
