COMMITTEES

Trial Committees: Nomad has 2 trials each year. Each Venue has its own committee. The Committee creates the format for the respective trial and plans/coordinates all logistics and aspects of the trial (premium creation, registration, site preparation, equipment, judges, volunteer workers, hospitality and more!). Seminar Committee: The seminar committee each year plans seminars, workshops, and camps. This is an exciting committee to be on. We invite top competitors/instructors to present the seminars. These seminars are for all members of the club. The committee has 1-2 meetings a year and does some of the planning via e-mail. There are many jobs to be done at the seminars (refreshments, setting courses, instructor hospitality, etc.). To be able to run the seminars, we ask committee members to put some time in working at the seminars.

Equipment Committee: Keeps track of the location of the equipment and maintains the equipment. Suggests and makes recommendation for the purchase of new equipment. Responsible for assuring equipment is trial-ready and delivered to trial site.

Membership Committee: Welcomes new members to the club by handling applications. Develops initiatives to keep the membership application and renewal process streamlined. Most issues and discussions are handled through email.
