### **Seminar Format: Two Half-Day Sessions**

“As a handler, [Jessica Ajoux](#) aims to be as precise and theoretically correct as possible. Her style is to stay out of the dog's way and not rush it. She likes to use a balance of techniques and handle in front of the dog as well as behind. She wants to have all the possible tools there are, so that no matter what she sees on the course, she has a solution. When Jessica is coaching her students, it's important for her to make sure they understand what they are doing and why. This goes for both the handlers and the dogs.”

“When [Perry](#) is handling, she likes to run and be ahead of her dog as much as possible. She enjoys finding the balance between being precise and being aggressive. As a coach, [Perry](#) is relatable and down to earth. Perry is sensitive to both the dog's and the human's mental and emotional state. Camp NOMAD Payment Policy: The \$300 (\$400 non-members) cost of camp is required with your registration to reserve a spot (checks will be deposited 7 days before the start of camp). No refunds will be given for withdrawals from camp after the closing date of May 8 unless the working spot is filled by another team. ***If you have registered and find you cannot attend and there is no waiting list, it will be your responsibility to find someone to fill your spot in order for you to receive a refund.*** Please check to see if there is a waiting list before giving your spot away.

Registrants will get a place in Camp based on the order of postmark, beginning with April 10, 2019. All registrations received before April 10 will be considered postmarked on April 10. If we receive more than 20 registrations postmarked April 10 or earlier, they will be assigned a working spot by random draw.

- Registrations postmarked after April 10 and before May 8 will be accepted in order of postmark.
- Full refund if you withdraw before May 8.
- Registrations will be available to non-members on April 24, if any vacancies exist

#### Please be aware of Camp Rules

- No talking among participants while the instructor is teaching.
- If your dog barks ringside, please crate away from the activity.
- You must clean up after your dog at the Field House and all surrounding areas. Please do not walk your dogs on the practice fields directly adjacent to the Field House.
- All dogs must be on a leash near the rings except when working. No Flexis.
- Practicing during off hours is not allowed in the working rings. The equipment is available to the instructors in off hours.
- Campers with working spot must stay with their assigned groups. You may work with alternate dogs during the weekend, but your alternate dog must be at or above the level of the dog you registered for camp.
- Auditor's dogs are not allowed in the working area during camp hours and are not allowed to use the equipment at any time.
